The University of Texas at Dallas is a state-supported institution of higher education founded in 1969 as a graduate school. The undergraduate school opened in August, 1975. Prior to the Fall of 1990 it was an upper-level university, granting admission to juniors, seniors, master and Ph.D. students. Freshman admissions were authorized in the Fall of 1990.

#### **TRANSCRIPTS**

The student record printed on the front will be either an undergraduate or a graduate transcript. If the student enrolled under both careers, both transcripts are present. An embossed seal of the University is not necessary. The signature of the University Registrar is in dark green on a light green background.

### SEMESTERS, SESSIONS, AND TERMS

An academic year consists of consecutive fall, spring, and summer semesters. Long semesters (fall and spring) are normally sixteen-weeks long. In addition, two eight-week sessions are offered during the long semester. The summer semester is normally eleven-weeks long. In addition, an eight-week and two five-week sessions are offered during the summer semester. The same academic credit is given for a course whether it is taken in the long semester sessions or the summer semester sessions.

### COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM AND ACADEMIC CREDIT

Course numbers at the University are four digits. The first digit indicates the level of the course: 0 or D = remedial/non-credit, 1 = freshman, 2 = sophomore, 3 = junior, 4 = senior, 5 - 9 = graduate courses. The second digit indicates the number of semester credit hours granted for the course (for "V" use the attempted hours).

Undergraduate students in a fast track program, or with approval, may register in graduate courses. The graduate courses taken by an undergraduate student, that apply towards a fast track program or are reserved for the graduate career, will appear on both the undergraduate and graduate transcripts if the career exists for the student. These graduate courses will count in the cumulative earned hours and GPA for both undergraduate and graduate careers. Graduate students may register in undergraduate courses. Courses reserved for a different career GPA calculation are notated with "Exclude Grade from Statistics" and transcribed under the correct career if the career exists for the student. Repeated coursework and courses satisfying the Texas General Education Core Curriculum are noted appropriately.

Courses listed as AERO, MILS, UTA, and UTSW are included on the transcript as part of collaborative academic arrangements with The University of North Texas, The University of Texas at Arlington and The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center.
