The University of Puget Sound was founded in 1888. It was known as the College of Puget Sound from 1913 to 1960, when it again became the University of Puget Sound. The University is fully accredited by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities, an institutional accrediting body recognized by the United Sates Department of Education and by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation.

CREDIT VALUE

Prior to Fall 1969, the University of Puget Sound operated on a semester calendar and granted credit in semester hours. From Fall 1969 through Spring 1984, the University operated on a 4-1-4 calendar and granted credit in units, with one unit as the equivalent of 3 1/3 semester credits or 5 guarter credits. Beginning Summer 1984, the University returned to a semester calendar, granting credit in units, with one unit as the equivalent of 4 semester credits or 6 guarter credits.

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Prior to Fall 1969, 125 semester credits were required for graduation. From Fall 1969 to Fall 1971, 35 units plus 4 PE activities were required for graduation. From Fall 1971 to Spring 1984, 36 units were required for graduation, with a maximum of 2 activity units allowed within the 36. Beginning Summer 1984. 32 units are required for graduation, with a maximum of 1.5 activity units allowed within the 32. Beginning Fall 1984, activity overload grades are excluded from the grade point average. To help track degree progress of students enrolled under both the 4-1-4 calendar (36-units degree) and semester calendar (32-unit degree), units earned prior to Summer 1984 were converted by a factor of 8/9. (The conversion factor derives from the change in units required from 36 to 32. Note that 32/36=8/9.) This conversion notation on the transcript is solely for the purpose of internal University degree-tracking. For purpose of transfer, unit equivalencies described above in Credit Value apply. Beginning in Fall 2011, 32 units are required for graduation, with a maximum of 2 activity units allowed within the 32.

Beginning Fall 1985, term (top line) and cumulative (bottom line) totals are: (1) graded units. (2) units earned, (3) grade points, and (4) grade point average.
