ACCREDITATION

CALENDAR SYSTEM

The academic year is divided into two semesters of approximately fifteen weeks each.

METHOD OF GRADE-POINT CALCULATION

The semester grade-point average is based on all courses taken in that semester, including failures. It is calculated by (1) multiplying credits for each course by quality points assigned to each grade earned; (2) totaling points earned for all courses; and (3) dividing total points by the number of credits attempted. The cumulative grade-point average is calculated in the above manner for all courses taken at Saint Joseph's College. Except for grades earned through the Greater Portland Alliance of Colleges & Universities, grades earned in courses accepted in transfer, or in courses approved to be taken at other colleges, are not calculated in either the semester or the cumulative grade-point average. Failed courses may be repeated with the most recent grade replacing the failure for grade point calculation. Both grades remain on the Academic Record.
