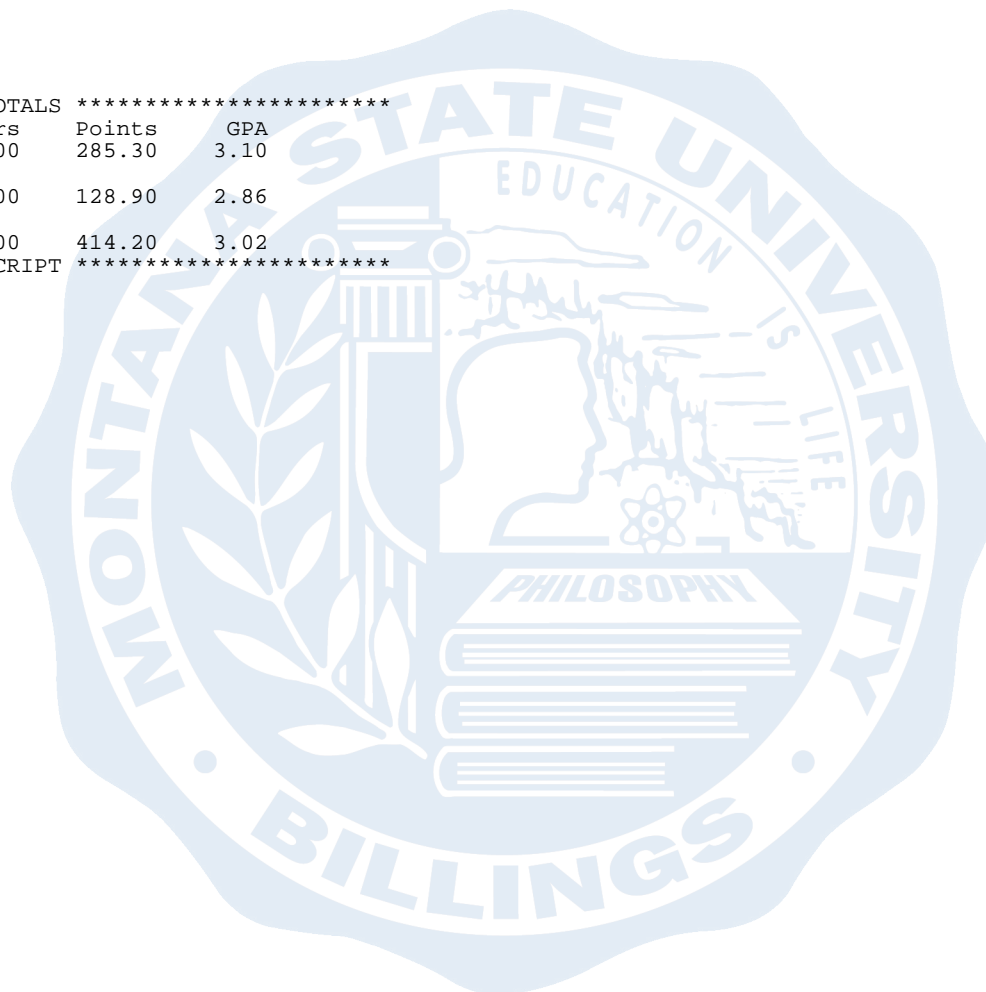

Fall semester begins in early September and ends in mid-December. Spring semester begins in January and ends in early May. Summer semester begins in mid-May and ends in late August.

Prior to Fall 1999, transfer course work appears on transcript under "*Comments*." Effective Fall 1999, transfer course work will appear as MSU Billings equivalent coursework, or as Lower or Upper Division elective course work, and is applied to student's level at time of transfer.

Prior to Fall 1999, Degree(s) Awarded are printed under "*Comments*" at each level (Undergraduate Quarter, Undergraduate Semester, Graduate Quarter, Graduate Semester). Effective Fall 1999, Degree(s) Awarded appear at the appropriate semester level (Undergraduate or Graduate).

"Transcript Totals" reflect cumulative totals by level. "Total Institution" represents course work completed at MSU Billings. "Total Transfer" represents course work accepted at MSU Billings. "Overall" combines "Total Institution" and "Total Transfer" totals.

Under "Fresh Start" undergraduate students may bankrupt up to two consecutive semesters (three quarters), saving "A", "B", and "P" grades. Bankrupted credits and grades will not be carried forward with the student's cumulative GPA.
