

Unless otherwise noted, all coursework is recorded in semester hours. The College's academic year is divided into three terms – Fall and Spring are sixteen weeks, Summer term is twelve weeks.

STATE OF FLORIDA ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

UNIT OF CREDIT

Broward College awards semester credits and vocational credits. Semester credits represent 15-16 hours of lecture instruction with 50-minute class periods. Short sessions and classes that meet less than three times per week are adjusted to include the same time equivalent as the 16 week terms. Vocational credit represents 37.5 hours of instruction.

INCOMPLETE GRADES

Students have until the end of the next major term to finish coursework; otherwise a failing grade for the course will be assigned.

GRADE FORGIVENESS

A student who has completed a course and desires to improve his/her grade for that course may repeat the course only if he/she has earned a "D" or "F" grade. The original grade remains on the transcript, but only the grade earned in the last attempt is used for calculating the grade point average.

TRANSFER CREDIT

Broward College evaluates transfer credits for degree-seeking students from institutions recognized by Broward College or who adhere to the Florida Statewide Course Numbering System. Previous course attempts are computed in the overall grade point average. Non-degree seeking students do not have their prior college work evaluated, and these credits may not appear on the Broward College transcript.
