It is my pleasure to recommend Philip Gyamfi for the M.P.A. program at The Evergreen State College. I have known him for about eight years now as a volunteer and employee for the federal Upward Bound (UB) programs at Evergreen, and I have seen him grow immensely as a professional in that time.

The Upward Bound program works with local high schools to help low-income, first-generation-to-college students in Tacoma, Lakewood, and Shelton to obtain a postsecondary degree. Overall, the educational aspiration levels of these communities are low, which makes students think themselves unfit for college. This is especially problematic because many of the students the program serves are students of color, who already face a barrage of obstacles on the path to higher education.

Philip currently works as an Educational Advisor for the Upward Bound Shelton program, and he has since October of 2021. But he began working with UB as a Night Security Guard for our residential Summer Learning Institute in 2015, and he has worked with the UB programs each summer since, continuing his role as Night Security before moving on to become Security Supervisor, Elective and Core Summer Class Instructor (2018, 2019, and 2022), and, finally, Student Success Coach. Philip has also volunteered regularly with the UB programs during the academic year in various capacities, including tutoring, presentations, and workshops, building deep, lasting relationships with all of the underrepresented students he has served.

In his various positions with UB, he worked one-on-one and with entire classes helping students to better understand the concepts they're learning, as well as helping them to develop leadership, college success, and cultural aptitude. Philip has always been sensitive to students' needs, and he has been patient and understanding when helping them work through their struggles. Staff and students alike appreciated his honesty and reliability, and, consequently, they began to see him as a friend and leader.

As he continued to work with the program over the years, I observed an intense passion emerge in him for education and helping disadvantaged youth, and this passion drove the tireless work he did and the unconditional compassion he demonstrated for the students he served. Since working with the UB program, he has gone on to conduct anti-genocide work with youth in Rwanda, and has a demonstrated interest in pursuing public service as a career.
