The institution changed its name in April 2009 to reflect expanded offerings that include baccalaureate degrees. Bellevue College offers educational programs in five general categories: bachelor degrees, transfer study, work-related training, adult basic education and continuing education.</p> <p>TRANSCRIPTS</p> <p>An official transcript is a copy of the student's academic record bearing the signature of the Registrar and is issued in a sealed college envelope.</p> <p>CONFIDENTIALITY</p> <p>All student educational records are handled in accordance with the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
