ACCREDITATION:

Lower Columbia College is accredited by the *Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU)*, the regional accrediting association. The College's Associate Degree in Nursing program is accredited by the *National League for Nursing*.

CALENDAR/CREDIT:

Credits are stated in quarter hours. A minimum of 90 applicable credit hours is required for an associate degree. A minimum of 180 applicable credit hours is required for a bachelor's degree. The academic year is divided into four quarters of approximately 11 weeks each. One credit is generally allowed for each discussion or laboratory period per week. The discussion period consists of 50 minutes of lecture or discussion; the laboratory period may consist of two or more 50-minute periods.

CERTIFICATES AND DEGREES AWARDED:

Associate in Arts, Associate in Arts and Sciences, Associate in Major, Associate in Sciences, Associate in Applied Science, Certificate of Proficiency, Certificate of Completion, High School Diploma, Bachelor of Applied Science. Bachelor's degrees are awarded for programs of four years. Associate degrees are awarded for programs of two years. Certificates of Proficiency are awarded for programs of one year or more. Certificates of Completion are awarded for programs of one year or less.

COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM:

001-049 - These courses are offered for high school completion or as community service. Credit toward an associate degree is not awarded.

050-099 - These courses may be applied toward an Associate in Applied Science Degree. Many of these courses are designed to promote development of employment skills.

100-299 - These courses may be applied toward any degree offered by Lower Columbia College. Most of these courses parallel lower-division courses offered by Washington four-year colleges and universities, with courses in the 100-199 series typically representing freshman year courses and 200-299 at the sophomore level. Courses ending in 1, 2, and 3 normally need to be taken in order.

300-Above - These upper-division courses may be applied toward a Bachelor of Applied Science degree.
