I am writing in support of Olivia (Andy) Bedne's application to the MPA program at Evergreen. Andy was an excellent student in my 2022-2023 program "Borders, Migrants and Refugees in the Age of the Climate Change" at The Evergreen State College and was a very able participant in our study abroad program to study global migration and borders in Morocco in the Spring of 2023. It is on this basis that I believe that Andy has the motivation and capacity to be very successful in the MPA program. I fully support their application.

Andy clearly has the intellectual and academic capabilities necessary to thrive in the MPA program. Andy can read difficult texts for comprehension, has a very good ability to quickly grasp an issue, case study or a policy debate and produce a good piece of written or participatory work. For example, Andy demonstrated a high level of understanding of the current international refugee system by writing an excellent policy paper that outlined how these limitations could be addressed through a new refugee system that broadened information sharing about refugees, provided enhanced rights to refugees and found new safe routes for resettlement.

Andy also has familiarity with issues that they will address more deeply in the MPA program. For example, in an Independent Learning Contract under my supervision, Andy demonstrated a strong ability to conduct independent research while working in the field (at a refugee NGO in France) where Andy was able to learn about grassroots refugee support organizations in Europe. Andy showed a strong grasp of the challenges that confront grassroots organizations with limited material resources and the organizational challenges faced by small organizations regarding decision-making and volunteer burnout and wrote cogently about these issues.

Finally, Andy has several helpful attributes to succeed in this program such as an excellent ability to work with others, an excellent ability to deal with diverse points of view and an excellent ability to be a supportive classmate. One of the best things about Andy is that while they have strong views about social justice they also have very grounded and practical views about how to make that happen through working through existing institutions and with others where they are. I think Andy can be an important member of the incoming MPA class and I hope you give them every consideration.
