COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM

A course number consists of three letters indicating academic department and three digits indicating the particular course. The first digit indicates the level at which the course is taught (1 for freshman, 2 for sophomore, 3 for junior, 4 for senior, 5 for graduate; 0 is generally used for remedial courses or certificate programs). Certificate programs used the 100 designation level prior to fall 2019.

GRADUATION WITH HONORS

The CGPA used for the determination of eligibility for any honors will include all college hours, including both HLGU and transfer hours for students earning a bachelor's degree. *Cum laude* indicates a CGPA from 3.5 up to but not including 3.7; *Magna cum laude* indicates a CGPA from 3.7 up to but not including 3.9; *Summa cum laude* indicates a CGPA of 3.9 and higher. Academic achievement indicates a CGPA of 3.5 and higher for students in a degree completion program or who finished less than half of their degree requirements at HLGU.
