Course Numbering

Courses that are numbered 100-299 are intended as transferable credit classes. Courses numbered 10-99 do not normally transfer to four year institutions. Courses that have 4 digits and begin with 9 are career technical.

Prior to Summer 1994, occupational (career technical) courses follow the digit- decimal system of numbering from 1.000. Beginning Summer 1994, career technical courses are also numbered 100-299.

Credit

Portland Community College operates on the quarter system. Credit earned at another institution and accepted by Portland Community College is recorded in quarter hours. Any information displayed reflecting transfer work accepted from other institutions should be verified with the original institution for accuracy.

Credit awarded by Portland Community College may include coursework completed at a contracting college as noted on the PCC transcript.

Continuing Education Units (CEUs)

Portland Community College works with professional associations and individual employers to offer jobrelated classes where students may earn Continuing Education Units (CEUs). One CEU is defined as 10 contact hours of participation in organized continuing education under qualified instruction. CEU's may not be applied toward any Portland Community College degree or certificate.

Beginning Fall 1998

Unless the course is repeated within one year, "CIPR" will change to an "AUD" after one year. Unless replaced with a final grade, "CIP" and "I" grades will change to "NP" or "F" (depending on the student's selected grading option) after one year. "I" grades prior to Fall 1998 will remain unchanged.

Beginning Summer 1994

Repeated courses are designated with an "E" in the repeat column when credit is disallowed. Repeated courses earning credit are calculated in the GPA.

Academic Fresh Start

Credit/grade points excluded via Academic Fresh Start are designated with an "E" in the repeat column. Excluded courses are not calculated in the GPA.

GPA Calculation

Cumulative totals and GPA include only terms shown on this transcript and may not include earlier terms taken at this college. Beginning April 25, 2008 only Portland Community College work is used in calculating the GPA, except for Oregon Coast Community College (OCCC) students nearing degree completion in 2014 when OCCC became a contracting college. For this population, transfer credit completed at OCCC, and transcripted by Clatsop Community College, is included in a Transfer GPA and the Overall GPA.
