So You Want to be a Psychologist was a 16-credit program where students deepened their understanding of the history and systems of psychology, as well as explored careers in psychology and the academic preparations necessary for these career choices. Hailey completed all of the work and demonstrated excellent critical thinking skills, especially in regard to the open science topics of replication and transparency.
