CEUs are not awarded for undergraduate academic credit and do not provide undergraduate academic credit and do not apply toward any degree or program of study. They may be awarded for a variety of experiences related to advancing knowledge and skills for a specific topic or occupation. CEU's are labeled "U" under the heading "CR TYPE." Starting Winter Quarter, 1998, all CEU course numbers are suffixed "U."
